SECTION 2: HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Classification: The product is not classified as hazardous according to Australia WHS 2 (2021).

Hazard Statements: Long-term contact of the product with the skin will cause damage to the skin.

Precautionary Statements: Avoid contact with skin, splash into the eyes, wear good safety gloves.



SECTION 3: COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

SECTION 4: FIRST-AID MEASURES

- Eye Contact: Wash immediately with water.
- Skin Contact: Wash with plenty of water and soap.
- Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting, get medical attention showing the SDS and the hazard label.
- Inhalation: Remove casualty to fresh air and keep warm and at rest.

SECTION 5: FIREFIGHTING MEASURES

- Extinguishing Media: Water. Carbon dioxide (CO₂). Suitable fire protection measures include fire water spray, chemical foam, and carbon dioxide dry powder fire extinguishing devices.
- Specific Hazards: Non-flammable. Do not inhale explosion and combustion gases; Burning produces heavy smoke.

SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

- Personal Precautions: Wear personal protection equipment. Remove persons to safety. Avoid contact with skin, splash into the eyes, wear good safety gloves.
- Environmental Precautions: Do not allow to enter into soil/subsoil. Do not allow to enter into surface water or drains. Do not put the product leak or place directly into drains, sewers, or soil.
- Methods for Cleaning Up: Suitable material for taking up includes absorbing material, organics, and sand. Wash with plenty of water. Try to avoid the leakage of products, avoid dust when product leakage is found, sweep it carefully and transfer it to a safe place in a bag. The leaked product can be mixed with sand or soil and dried to form solid waste, which can be treated as construction waste.

- Handling: Avoid contact with skin and eyes, inhalation of vapours and mists. Do not eat or drink while working. Do not need to take any special measures to use.
- Storage: Keep away from food, drink and feed. To avoid dampness, keep in a cool dry place. Store in adequately ventilated premises.
