SECTION 2: HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

2.1 Classification of the Substance or Mixture

Not classified as DANGEROUS GOODS by the criteria of the Australian Dangerous Goods Code (ADG Code) for transport by Road and Rail.

SECTION 3: COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

- Eye Contact: If splash into the eye, rinse immediately with plenty of water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- Skin Contact: In case of skin contact, rinse immediately with water and soap. If skin irritation occurs, get medical advice.
- Inhalation: Remove victim to fresh air.
- Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water to dilute the substance. Seek immediate medical attention or contact a poison control centre.

SECTION 5: FIREFIGHTING MEASURES

- Extinguishing Media: Suitable fire protection measures include fire water spray, chemical foam, and carbon dioxide dry powder.
- Specific Hazards: Product is not flammable.

SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

- Personal Precautions: Wear appropriate protective equipment such as safety gloves. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- Environmental Precautions: Keep product from entering drains, sewers, or waterways.
- Methods for Cleaning Up: Scrape up the majority of the material. Collect and transfer it to a safe place in a bag. It can also be rinsed with large amounts of water, diluted, and then put into the wastewater system. For large leakages, cover with plastic cloth or canvas. The leaked product can be mixed with sand or soil and dried to form solid waste, which can be treated as construction waste.

- Handling: Use in well ventilated areas. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear good safety gloves. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
- Storage: To avoid dampness, keep in a cool, dry place. Keep the containers in a dry, well ventilated space, away from sources of heat and ignition. Containers must be kept tightly closed. Store at temperatures above 0 degrees Celsius. Keep away from moisture.
